Dec. 31, 1903		Marriage license has been issued to R. H. Burt and Maud Graham of Richardson.
Aug 19, 1905	Richardson:	Mr. and Mrs. R. H. Burt have moved their household effects back to Richardson, where they will reside in the future
Dec. 9, 1905	Richardson:	Robert Burt has moved into Olsen Barnes' house at Hunters Bay and has a force of men cutting wood on the place which he recently bought from Wm. Graham.
February 3, 1906		Robert Burt and Thomas Graham returned from Bellingham last week with three horses.
Mar 3, 1906	Richardson:	Robert Burt returned Saturday from Anacortes, where he went to sell some cord wood.
Apr 13, 1907	Richardson:	The logging camp of Graham & Burt has 225,000 feet of logs in the water, and 200,000 cut in the woods, and Mr. Graham says they have just begun.
June 8, 1907	Richardson:	Thos. Graham and Robt. Burt have resumed logging operations.
Nov 16, 1907	Richardson:	The logging firm of Graham and Burt have a large force of men cutting cord wood.
Feb 8, 1908	Richardson:	Graham & Burt have commenced logging again.
Mar 14, 1908	Richardson:	Robert Burt returned Saturday from Bellingham where he went to sell some logs.
Apr 11. 1908	Richardson:	Born, to Mr. and Mrs. Robt. Burt, Sun. Mar. 22, a girl. [Note: Evelyn Jennie Burt]
Apr 8, 1910	Richardson:	Burt, Graham and Co. are "booming" logs instead of Richardson.
July 29, 1910	Richardson:	Burt and Graham are booming logs at Hunter's Bay.
Oct. 21, 1910	Richardson	R. H. Burt is carrying the mail as substitute for Mr. Kent, who has moved away.
June 27, 1913	Richardson:	Albin Graham and Robert Burt took a crowd from Lopez to the dance at Olga Saturday evening on their launch Evelyn.

July 4, 1913		Born Friday June 27, to Mr. and Mrs. Robert Burt, a son. [note: would be: Vernon Thomas Burt]
November 14, 1913	Lopez Island	Mrs. Robt Burt with several friends and relatives started for Seattle Wednesday morning on the launch Evelyn to make a short visit with relatives.
Jan 16, 1914		Robert Burt of Port Stanley was in Friday Harbor the first of the week.
