Ransom Keeney's Descendants.

Ransom K. married Dec. 27, 1834, Rohanna, daughter of Peter and Abigail Orcutt Huntsinger. Peter's mother was Anna Payne, a sister of Dollie Payne, who married James Madison, fourth President of the United States. He taught the first school taught in Chatham. He lived at Holiday most of his life, where he was loved and respected by all who knew him. He died Oct. 19, 1903, in his 93d year. Rohanna, a great reader, was considered to be one of the best informed women in Middlebury, died Dec. 27, 1895. They are buried in the Briggs cemetery. Their children were Rosaltha, born Feb. 18, 1836; Carolyn, born 1838; Angela, born Oct. 7, 1839; Adelbert, born 1841; Beatrice, born April 9, 1843; Saleman, born May 24, 1845; Mortimer, born June 19, 1848; Helintha, born 1851; Cassimer, born 1853; Sydney H., born 1856.

Rosaltha K. married Luther West in 1852. She was an active Christian worker, teacher of the Bible class for 9 years; bright and cheerful, she was loved by all who knew her. She passed most of her life at Holiday where she died Feb. 1, 1902. Luther served in Co. F, 11th U.S. Cavalry. He was an honest, upright man and soon followed his wife. He died Dec. 1, 1902. They are buried in Fairview cemetery at Holiday. Their children were Ell Doran, Corrinne and Lenna.

Ell Doran married Jane, daughter of John Dougherty. He is an oil driller now in Texas.

Corrinne was educated at Mansfield and taught school for several years. She was married March 4, 1883, to Edward D. Fisher, a farmer and lumberman of Wellsboro, where they now reside.

Lenna married Victor Whitney, by whom she had one son, Harry, who lived with his aunt Corrinne until his marriage with Minnie Suhr, September, 1902. Harry served two years with 11th U.S. Cavalry at Manila. He now lives at Niagara Falls with his wife and little child, Louise C.

Lenna was married Oct. 14, 1882, to Ira Whitney and lives on her father's farm at Holiday. Their children are Neva, Nida and Luther. Neva married Steven Bates, of Tioga.

Angela, a good singer and musician, married Lou Howard. She is buried at Muskegon, Mich.

Adelbert enlisted in the 11th U.S. Cavalry in 1861, and was discharged in 1865. He received injuries which resulted in his death. He is buried at Arlington Heights, Washington.

Saleman also served in 11th U.S. Cavalry, going while but a boy. He died from the effects of his service in 1866.

Beatrice married George Goodwin, of Middlebury, where they now reside. Their children, Floyd, died age 6 years; Fred, born in 1866. A good Christian boy, loved by all. He died of diphtheria in 1880, and Leroy died when 3 months old. They are not lost but gone before.

Mortimer C.K. married Martha Adams in 1875. They live at Hammonds. Their only son Clarence, served in Co. K of the Spanish-American war. He married Emma Ham and resides at Tioga. They have three children, Marion, Louise and Mortimer C.

Cassimer married Kate Harkness and now lives at Wellsboro. He composes music and was a band leader. Their children are Pearl, who graduated from Wellsboro High school and taught school several terms. She married John Obourn, of Mansfield, Nina, Ransom and Harold.

Sidney H.K. married Fannie Dowling in 1877. He has run a harness shop at Wellsboro for 16 years. He composes music and was a band leader. Their children are Floyd, now on the Pacific coast traveling with a first-class Minstrel show as a cornet player and singer, and Blanche and Mazie who both graduated from Wellsboro High school. Mazie is now teaching school.

KEENEY Ransom

Wellsboro Agitator, Tioga, PA--Wednesday, October 28, 1903

Crooked Creek, Oct 27--The death, at his home here on the 19th instant, of Mr Ransom Keeney, aged 91, severed another of the very few links connecting Tioga county of the present with the pioneer epoch in its progress. The deceased was born April 5, 1812 in Syracuse, NY but when only 4 years old, was brought to this locality by his parents when they settled here. At that time this region was an almost primeval wilderness, the pioneer settler's neighbors were but few, and comforts and some of the necessities of life, were secured only with difficulty. Mr Keeney married Rhoana Huntsinger, December 27, 1834. To them were born 11 children, 4 of whom survive: Mrs George Goodwin of this place, Mr M C Keeney of Tioga and C P and S H Keeney of Wellsboro. The deceased was the great-grandfather of Mr Harry Keeney of Wellsboro and the gr-gr-grandfather of Harry's daughter, Louise, aged 8 weeks. He leaves also other descendants besides those named. When Mr Keeney was young he taught school for several terms. He then bought and cleared the farm now owned by Eugene Keeney. Except a few years passed in Michigan, the subject of this sketch spent his worthy life in Middlebury twp. He was a lifelong, Christian, never used profane language or drank intoxicants. Being possessed of an amicable and loving disposition he won the respect and esteem of all who knew him. The deceased was great, great grandfather of Harry Whitney, of Wellsboro, who has a child two months old.
